From the Principal.....

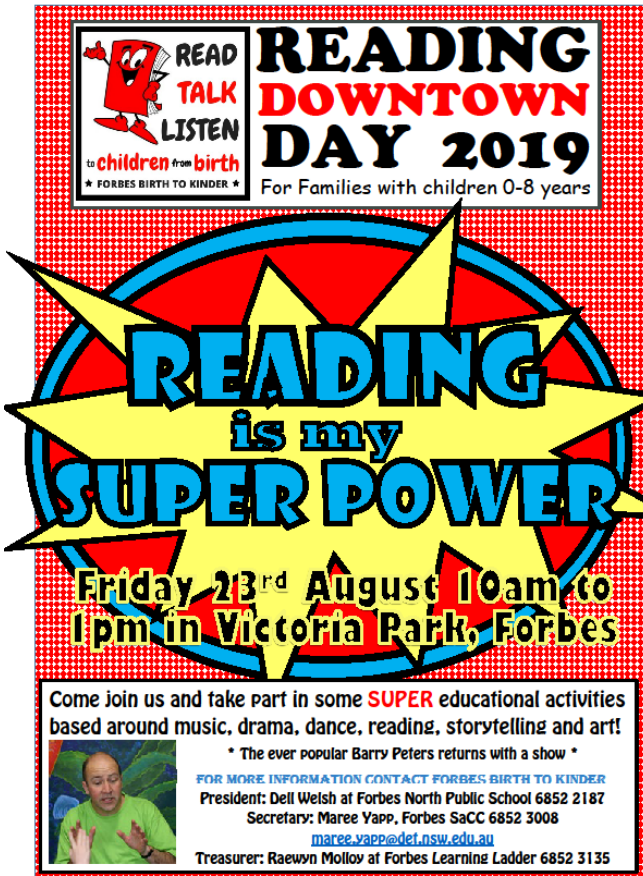
How awesome was our Education Week Showcase, "Every Student, Every Voice" last Thursday night?!?!

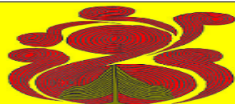
