Please note, the form is being sent home today. It would be appreciated if you could return to the school office ASAP. It is essential that student details are current and updated if any changes occur.

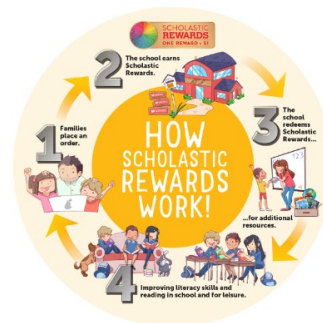
Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC)

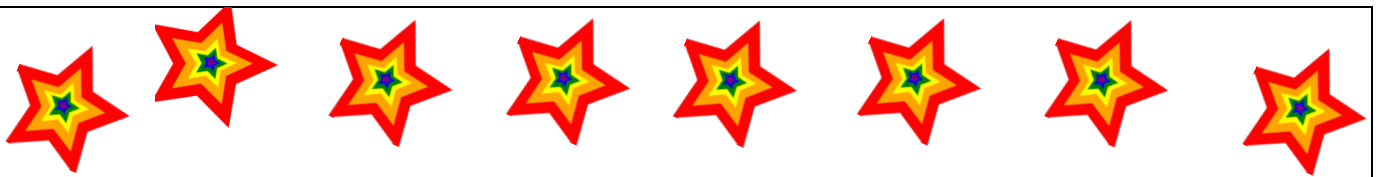
