Macaroni and Cheese Muffins

Ingredients

1 cup macaroni – pre cooked 1/4 cup grated pumpkin 1/4 cup grated carrot 1 tablespoon water 1 tablespoon self-raising flour 30 mL milk 1/2 teaspoon Dijon mustard 2 small eggs 65 g corn kernels 1 cup grated cheddar cheese 1 tablespoon parmesan cheese (divided between the muffins)

Method

1 Preheat oven to 180oC.

2 Put paper cases into muffin tin.

3 Peel and grate carrot.

4 Grate pumpkin.

5 Put carrot, pumpkin and water into a microwave safe bowl and cook on high for 2 minutes. Helpers to assist with this step.

6 Helpers to take bowl out of microwave and take lid off.

7 Using a fork, mash the pumpkin and carrot – just a little.

8 Put the flour into a large bowl and add milk, mustard and eggs and whisk gently until all ingredients combined.

9 Mix in the grated cheddar cheese, corn, mashed vegetables and macaroni. Mix well with a wooden spoon.

10 Using a metal spoon, divide the mixture into the muffin cases.

11 Sprinkle the top of each muffin with a little parmesan cheese.

12 Helpers to place muffin trays into oven.

13 Bake for 20 minutes until golden brown. Cool for at least 15 minutes before serving.

In week 10 of term 2, 3/40 enjoyed visiting the kitchen to make macaroni and cheese muffins. The students continued to develop their skills of peeling, grating and cutting as well as reading a recipe. The students were initially not keen on the muffins as they had lots of veggies in them, however they decided they turned out quite yummy! We have included the recipe to share with you all as we think they make a wonderful lunchbox snack.

Service NSW \$100 Creative Kids Vouchers



The NSW Government is helping kids get creative with the new Creative Kids program.

Parents, guardians and carers can apply for a voucher with a value of up to \$100 per calendar year for each student aged 4.5 to 18 years old enrolled in school.

The voucher may be used with a registered activity provider for registration, participation and tuition costs for

creative arts, speech, drama, dance, digital design, coding, and music

lessons and activities. Vouchers can also be used for the purchase of creative kits and art supplies from registered providers.

Vouchers can be used at any time during the calendar year it was issued.


