National Science Week is one of those weeks where opportunity and curiosity collide. Our students from kindergarten to Year 6 without mentioning the lesson and experiences offered in classrooms have attended multiple events across the region and at school. Year 5 attended the Central West Eco Sustainability Day held at Parkes Racecourse, Years 3 to 6 attended the National Science Week Extravaganza held at Forbes Town Hall with experiment, explosions, and explanation the order of the day. Our whole school were delighted with the Troppo Magic performance by Troppo Bob where science had to be seen to be believed with gravity defying and unexplained phenomena on show combined with magic, message, and humour. Our Year 3 and Year 4 students visited the Wellington Caves to explore these ancient caves and to try and comprehend the millions of years it has taken for these amazing natural wonders to form and continue to change. Every student at Forbes North were presented with an inspiring presentation from CMOC Northparkes Mine staff who have donated 24 roosting boxes for native birds to find a home within the playground at Forbes North Public School. Year 6 students, and Kindergarten then painted the boxes prior to them being lifted into place in spring after some final preparations are completed. In the space of a week our 237 students have studied and experienced ecology, geology, biology, physics, chemistry and perhaps these events ignite the interest in science that lasts a lifetime.

Last Friday a delegation of senior students visited Miss Annemarie Goodger in the office and congratulated our School Administrative Manager with a substantial bunch of flowers and a 20-year certificate of service. This level of dedication and long-standing passion for Forbes North is nothing short of astounding. If you are calling past the office in the coming days, please acknowledge this wonderful person and servant to FNPS. Last week we acknowledged the 33 students who attended the Lachlan PPSA Zone Athletics Carnival and now we discover 19 will go onto Dubbo and the Western Regional Athletics Carnival. This is a magnificent achievement and is supported by Ace Hancock who returned from Griffith representing Western Region at the New South Wales Football Championships. Ace should be congratulated for his efforts and the experience will be one to remember. Finally, we have two esteemed guests visiting Forbes next week with Federal Member for Riverina coming to FNPS on Tuesday 30 August to view our parliament in action and on Thursday 1 September, the Deputy Secretary School Performance of the Department of Education visits Forbes and tours our school including a visit to several classrooms. Our celebration tallies have been updated.



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






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Reading up North is being held in conjunction with 2022 CBCA Book Week at Forbes North Public School on Thursday 25 August 2022.

Over the weekend we had Gunn Carpet Cleaning refurbish our carpets in the administration buildings, library, and staffroom while 9 dangerous and protruding tree stumps were removed from the playground to improve both safety and the aesthetic appeal of our natural spaces. Over 30 cubic metres of high-quality mulch have been deposited across the playground for our gardens while new tables, seating and school bubblers are currently being sourced for installation over the coming months. Cherry Energy are installing 60 new solar panels on the rooves covering the Kindergarten classrooms while Mr. Potts and Mr. Markwort will install new flagpoles at the school entrance as soon as the weather allows these works to commence.
